Thank you for providing input regarding the opening of the upcoming school year. The individual comments and feedback given during your personal conversations with Leslie Vasquez and Chad Meeks were invaluable.

As a result, the Key Pandemic Task Force and Re-Entry Team recommended to the Key Center Board of Directors that the school start date be pushed back. The board voted yesterday to move the start date to Tuesday, September 8, 2020.

Today, the Tarrant County Health Department announced that all schools in Tarrant County remain virtual through September 28, 2020. This mandate means Key School will begin the new school year with distance learning. Key School leadership has been aware of this possibility throughout their summer planning process and has spent months preparing for this likelihood. The entire Key team is eager to begin the 2020 – 2021 school year and will continue the excellence in education that Key School has provided for over 50 years.
